THE STADIUM

One distinctive feature of the Miami Grand Prix is its utilization of the Hard Rock Stadium. During the race weekend, the stadium is open for fans to explore.

The Stadiums field is where the Formula One Paddock is located. Guests are welcome to sit in the stadium seats and take a peak at the inner workings of paddock life. It's a fun chance to spot drivers, team members, and celebrities.

Beyond just the Formula One Paddock, the stadium also has excellent amenities for guests to enjoy. Everything from bars, food stalls, water fountains, shaded seating, and even free Wi-Fi can be found inside.

IMPORTANT!

The Miami Grand Prix has a strict stadium bag policy in place for all fans!

of the Miami Grand Prix track?

GRANDSTAND TICKETS

Grandstand tickets at the F1 Miami Grand Prix offer prime views of the action from key track locations, including high-speed straights and turns. Fans enjoy elevated seating (a must in Miami), great race visibility, and access to food, drinks, and merchandise, making for an unforgettable experience. Make sure you pay attention to location when booking your Grandstand tickets. The track is broken down into 9 different zones each with their own attractions, atmosphere, food, and shade options. If you want to be close to shade and the fan zone grandstands near the Promenade zone or the Fountains will be key.

GENERAL ADMISSION

GA tickets to the F1 Miami Grand Prix provide fans with an affordable way to experience the excitement of F1. While seating may not be included, fans can expect an electric atmosphere, giant screens for live race coverage, and access to food, drinks, and entertainment throughout the venue. General admission offers a great way to soak in the high-speed action without the premium price.

CLUB+ HOSPITALITY

Club and Hospitality tickets for the F1 Miami Grand Prix offer a premium experience with exclusive seating, gourmet dining, open bars, and VIP access. These tickets provide luxury amenities, prime race views, and an elevated atmosphere for an unforgettable race weekend. While pricey the experience fans get in Miami is said to be unbeatable.

BEST VIEWING LOCATIONS

SIGHT-SEEING & ATTRACTIONS

Popular grandstand locations at the F1 Miami Grand Prix offer a range of exciting views:

- **NW + SW Helix** – A prime location for GA ticket holders to witness turns 4, 5 & 6
- **Turn 1 Grandstand** – Ideal for high-intensity action, as drivers brake hard and battle for position on the opening lap.
- **Turn 9 Grandstand** – Overlooks a fast, sweeping corner, giving fans a great view of cars at high speed.
- **Marina Grandstand** – Located near the track's luxury yacht-style setup, providing a unique and vibrant atmosphere.
- **Turn 18 Grandstand** – Positioned before the long main straight, making it perfect for watching overtakes and late-braking maneuvers.

Each grandstand offers a different perspective, allowing fans to choose between high-speed thrills, technical corners, or the spectacle of the start and finish line.

THE STADIUM

The major benefit of having a massive stadium in the middle of a race track are the views it provides. Ride up the escalator to the top of the stadium to watch from inside the shaded stadium on the big screens or stand along the upper walls for a view of the track.

GONDOLAS

A fun and novel way to get a birds eye view of the Miami track is from the Heineken Gondolas. Rides only last for 20 minutes but its a memorable way to view the track if you have some free time.

HELIXS

Don't forget to explore the Hard Rock Stadium for amazing views of the F1 track! Fans often watch from the buildings many helixes and upper railing which provide unparalleled views.

PARKING

Parking at the Miami Grand Prix is limited and must be purchased in advance, with options ranging from general parking to premium and VIP spots near the Miami International Autodrome. Shuttle services and park-and-ride options are available to help manage traffic congestion. Due to high demand, fans are encouraged to arrive early or consider alternative transportation such as rideshare services or public transit to ensure a smooth race day experience.

RIDESHARE

Rideshare services like Uber and Lyft are a convenient way to get to and from the Miami Grand Prix, with designated pick-up and drop-off zones near the Miami International Autodrome. Drop off locations are can be up to a mile away form the track to be prepared to walk if needed.

Be aware. Due to high demand, surge pricing and wait times skyrockets, especially after the race, so planning ahead or exploring alternative transportation options is recommended. Don't be afraid to stay at the track and get a drink and bite to eat while you wait for demand to slow down. Its a great way to explore the track with fewer people hanging around.

BRIGHTLINE TRAIN

Taking the Brightline to the Miami Grand Prix offers a convenient and stress-free transportation option for fans traveling from West Palm Beach, Fort Lauderdale, and other nearby cities. Special event trains and shuttle services connect directly to the Miami International Autodrome, providing a seamless journey without the hassle of traffic or parking. With comfortable seating, onboard amenities, and express service, Brightline is a great way to enhance the race weekend experience.

REMINDER

No parking passes will be sold day of. They MUST be purchased ahead of time online.

TRANSPORTATION



BAG POLICY

SIGHT-SEEING & ATTRACTIONS

Due to the unique nature of utilizing an NFL stadium, the Formula One Miami Grand Prix has a strict bag policy. Only the following bags are allowed inside the track.

WHAT TO PACK

Your bag is your lifeline at any F1 event. When packing a track bag for an F1 Grand Prix, include essentials like a hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, ear protection, a portable phone charger, and a reusable water bottle.

BAG CHECK

F1 fans who accidentally bring bags that are too large and who do not want to return them to a vehicle can always use the track's Bag Check station. Prices range from \$21-42 depending on bag size.

RE-ENTRY

Tickets to the Miami Grand Prix do not allow re-entry for fans who wish to leave. Please be mindful of what you wish to bring with you each day and know that a quick trip to the car will not be possible if you want to drop things off.

- Clear plastic bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Small bags or fanny packs that do not exceed 4.5" x 6.5"
- Diaper Bags are allowed but will be searched
- Empty water bottles are allowed under 32oz
- Empty Camelback Hydration packs with NO pockets

Other restricted and prohibited items include professional filming and photography equipment, drones, large signs and aerosol sunscreen.

To avoid a very frustrating experience with event security make sure you read the track FAQ's and follow all stated guidelines.

*Small personal cameras will be allowed into the Miami Grand Prix
